**Being a pedicab rider will allow you to be your own boss, work your own hours and get paid in cash. Below you will find the answers to some of the most common questions about riding with Ballpark Pedicabs.**

### **What is my title for this cool job?**

Your title is pedicab rider. You are an ambassador of San Diego for anyone who gets on your pedicab.

### **Whom am I riding for?**

Ballpark Pedicabs was founded in June of 2001 by a group of guys who wanted to do something "fun" and not have to be anyone's boss. As a result, they started a pedicab company that strictly leases bikes to self-starting and self-motivated riders.

Ballpark Pedicabs operates the only fully automated shop, which allows riders 24-hour access to their bikes. Riders receive an electronic pass key that allows them to access the building to pick up and return their bikes. A drop safe is located in the shop so that riders can drop their lease payments and continue to ride the following week without any interruption.

Ballpark Pedicabs prides itself on having the best maintained bikes in the industry. An expert pedicab mechanic from a local bicycle shop maintains the bikes to ensure the safety and reliability of our bikes.

### **What is the Geographical Scope (what areas will I work)?**

As a pedicab rider you are fully mobile. You are free to travel wherever you would like. Most commonly you would travel along the ocean front by the Star of India, up the coast to Shelter Island, through Little Italy, into the Business District, through the vibrant Gaslamp Quarter, to the San Diego Convention Center or into Seaport Village.

### **What general information can you give me about the position?**

This is a great job for individuals who are outgoing, self-motivated, self-starting and looking to get into great shape. As a pedicab rider you are an ambassador for all different types of people from all over the world. The patrons who will use your services range from tourists wanting a tour of the Downtown Area, women and men needing a ride back to their car after a long night of dancing, couples looking for a place to eat or have a couple cocktails, and local residents needing a ride from the local grocery store to their home.

### **What makes this position cool?**

Where else can you work where you are your own boss, work your own hours, get in great shape, meet men and women who are having a great time in one of the most beautiful climates in the world... all while getting paid in cash?

### **What kind of person does it take to become a pedicab rider?**

As a rider you must have a valid driver's license (from anywhere), be at least 18 years of age, have a pedicab license, speak some English, be fun, outgoing, self-motivated and be in semi-good shape.
